Footnotes

MISTIE ROYALE was rated three deep tracking off the second flight racing to the backstretch, switched outside foes entering the far turn commencing a steady, four wide advance and continued with a solid late response in that path to late stages to narrowly prevail between foes on the wire under firm handling. WINNING STAR reserved in last to the backstretch, switched outside foes racing into the far turn making steady progress five deep, steadily moved to challenge for command in that path near the sixteenth marker, gained the advantage between calls late and just failed to contain the winner's final kick. HELLO JAKE gained a forward placing tracking just off the first flight racing to the backstretch, commenced an early challenge for command midway through the backstretch, forged clear on the far turn to gain a commanding advantage racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain her momentum. MODESTA, pulling a bit against restraint while being guided to the inside early, tracked off the second flight, shifted out of tight quarters racing into the far turn, continued with interest to split foes four wide racing into upper stretch and continued to gain some position while no menace to the top trio. ART OF DECEPTION, urged to gain a forward placing tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, continued with a steady bid pursuing the leader into the far turn but came up empty racing into upper stretch. TSUNAMI SALLI tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, steadied in close quarters racing into the far turn and couldn't menace in the final quarter. S S DESSERT FIRST, urged to gain a position inside foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out to lodge a brief bid between foes racing into the far turn but steadily faded in the drive. A. J.'S LOVE hopped at bit at the start, was righted to track between foes off the second flight, raced in some close quarters entering the second bend and dropped out early. ANCIENT EYES broke sharply, tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch but was through after a half. RUN MAMA BEARE RUN was hustled to the lead, dictated the pace for a half, chased the leader into the far turn and gave way nearing upper stretch.
