Footnotes

FRIENDLY BANTER was settled out of striking distance along the inside racing to the backstretch, swung outside foes racing through the far turn gathering momentum four wide, was fanned six wide entering the stretch, shifted inwards under pressure while moving to challenge for command outside DEAD ON in the closing stages while carrying that rival inwards a bit but narrowly prevailed in time under strong handling. DEAD ON tracked off the second flight outside rivals in the opening half, was urged to split foes leaving the far turn to challenge four deep between foes entering upper stretch, was carried inwards a bit in the closing stages while contesting the issue to the end but was just outfinished. CODE OF CONDUCT settled out of striking distance along the rail in the opening half, shifted out of close quarters to race five wide into upper stretch and made an effort to gain some position between foes while earning a share. PRINCEVILLE CONDO was rated just out of striking distance tracking the pacesetter outside a rival in the opening half, made a steady advance on the leader to challenge between foes racing into upper stretch but was outkicked. MAVERICKING shifted in early bumping CLEMENT ROCK, while moving to gain a position along the rail, tracked just off the second flight along the inside into the second bend, awaited an opening inside foes racing through the far turn, then shifted out to split foes three wide in the closing stages while gaining some position. CLEMENT ROCK, bumped in the opening

stages, was rated off the second flight near the inside early, shifted out to split foes racing into the far turn while making some brief progress but had no closing bid. NORTH OF NEVER tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight early, shifted out three deep racing into the far turn and soon gave way. ADIOS NARDO, forwardly placed along the rail tracking the pacesetter in the opening half, made brief progress inside foes racing into the far turn but emptied out in upper stretch. BIG LOOIE, prompted to secure the lead, pulled his way clear racing into the backstretch while refusing his rider's attempt to rate his speed, maintained a clear margin into the second bend and emptied out abruptly racing into upper stretch. MACHO BULL, held up avoiding tight quarters at the start, never gained contention.
