TAZZ stumbled at the start then rated in the second flight, made a five wide move and drew clear. AND THE BEAST settled inside early then angled out turning into the stretch and was gaining late. UNO PECADOR set the pace and led to the stretch but faded late. CANNON'S CALL was jostled at the start, rated in the middle of the pack, was asked but raced evenly. DAVES RIVER raced close up, battled between horses and tired in the stretch. UNO CHAPO had a rail trip, drifted out coming off the turn and passed tiring rivals. DR. DON stalked the pace, contended to the stretch but faltered. WHODO rated in the second flight between horses, was boxed in on the turn but made no rally. CREOLE'S AFFAIR showed no speed, was asked but made no rally. REGGIO'S ROCK STAR was void of speed and dropped back then was no factor.
