**Footnotes**

DOUBLE JUMP broke outwards exchanging some contact with DAKOTA METT, was reserved along the inside racing just out of striking distance in the opening quarter, shifted out three wide nearing the quarter mile marker to challenge, took charge in upper stretch and drew well clear while being kept to steady pressure. SUNSHINE SUPERMAN, brushed by DAKOTA METT at the start, was reserved between foes near the inside early, saved ground on the bend, shifted out three wide entering upper stretch and continued well enough to secure the place. DAKOTA METT broke inwards making some contact with DOUBLE JUMP, swerved out brushing SUNSHINE SUPERMAN, was quickly righted to dispute the pace along the rail, dueled for command into upper stretch but gave way when proving no match. JINGLE JANGLE was settled outside foes in the opening stages, angled inwards on the turn and continued along the rail to late stages while improving his position. FAMILIAR SHINE joined a rival on the pace while under some reserve in early stages, pressed the issue to upper stretch and gave way. SKIP THE HATCHET tracked just off the first flight three deep racing to the turn, drifted out after a half and gave way. BUSY LAD, caught four wide tracking the leaders in second flight racing to the turn, emptied out early.
