Footnotes

WILDCAT MISS sped to the fore to gain the advantage on her own courage in the opening stages, set the pace in that manner racing into the bend, edged clear entering upper stretch and steadily widened her margin under hand urging late. PURE POLISHED was settled between foes in the last flight racing to the bend, shifted out on the turn commencing her advance, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch but continued with interest to just edge a rival for place honors. RANSOM ZIP tracked just off the first flight along the rail under light rating racing into the bend, came through inside foes when presented an opening entering upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner and was outfinished for second. ROCK 'N' ROLL GAL was prompted to gain terms with the leaders racing three wide between foes in the opening quarter, lost some position to those foes racing through the turn, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch while being urged to make a second effort and was outfinished for a share. SEEKING REASON, urged to contend four deep while gaining terms with the first flight after the opening furlong, continued chasing the pacesetter three deep to upper stretch and gave way. A SHOT AWAY vied for command under pressure between foes racing into the turn and gave way after a half. DOROTHY Y was settled outside foes in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge.
