Footnotes

THECUSHMAKER broke slowly, was immediately guided to the rail gaining a position just off the second flight racing to the backstretch, steadily drew into striking distance while shifting off the inside on the far turn, swung out five wide in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under pressure. GOLDWAY moved to the fore along the inside to dictate the pace on a narrow margin to the backstretch, shook clear racing through the far turn to open a commanding advantage racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain her momentum. DUBIOUS was settled a bit off the inside as part of the last flight racing to the backstretch, circled into striking distance five deep racing through the far turn, was fanned six wide entering upper stretch but continued with interest to improve her placing while earning a share. CHAIN OF DESTINY, held up off the leaders to race inside foes in the second flight in the opening half, moved to challenge between foes near the inside entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. HOLYCOW SHES SASSY, reserved in the last flight while being guided to the rail in the opening stages, saved ground throughout while gaining some position racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. POINT YOUR FINGER, reserved in last near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out leaving the far turn to split foes four wide gaining some position in late stages while making no real impression on the leaders. CYBERPHOBE tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight in the opening half, made a brief, three wide bid on the far turn but quickly came up empty in the drive. SEE NO STARS, reserved between foes in the second flight in the opening half, lacked the needed closing response. EILEEN EVELYN, caught four wide racing into the first turn while being prompted to gain a forward placing, steadily faded racing into the far turn. LUCKY GAL, urged to secure terms on the pace between foes racing to the backstretch, couldn't match the pacesetter after five furlongs and emptied out early. LIVE TODAY was pulled up after a half as a result of slipped saddle but

walked off the course under her own power.
