Footnotes

NO RETREAT angled in sharply just after the start to gain a position along the rail while herding in BLOOMING FLOWER, tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance to the second bend, steadily drew into contention while shifting out nearing the furlong marker then advanced in close quarters splitting foes three deep to narrowly prevail under right handed encouragement. SOMALI BYRD was held up along the inside tracking the first flight in the opening half continued in that fashion into the second bend, shifted out four wide nearing the furlong marker while being urged to challenge, was outkicked by the winner but narrowly prevailed for place honors. LOVE THY NEIGHBOR pulled her way to to the lead while angling over racing to the first turn, dictated the pace along the inside into the second bend, briefly resisted when challenged racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain her bid while lasting for a share. PASCHENDALE tracked the pace between foes in the second flight from just out of striking distance early, moved to press the issue three deep racing into the far turn to upper stretch and was outkicked in the drive while shifting inwards under pressure late. KITCHEN BOSS, urged to secure a forward placing while shifting outside the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, pressed the pace between foes on the far turn to upper stretch, weakened in late stages and was taken in hand avoiding PASCHENDALE nearing the wire. BREWMISTRESS tracked off the second flight in the opening half, made some progress to lodge a brief, four wide bid racing through the far turn to upper stretch but flattened out late. LITTLE MARY E broke inwards bumping MISSION STORM soundly, was steadied in close quarters just after the break, continued well off the second flight to the far turn and never gained contention. MISSION STORM, bumped soundly at the start, swerved out just after the break, settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. SILVER ENCORE broke slowly, settled along the inside and never mounted a serious challenge. CHARLOTTE'S CAPE hopped, then was caught in tight quarters just after the start, settled outside foes and never mounted a serious challenge. BLOOMING FLOWER herded to the inside in the opening stages by the

eventual winner, steadily faded from contention after a half.
