TOO MANY SINS rated in the middle of the pack, was asked while five wide and made a steady advance to get up in time. MORALITY was allowed to settle, made a bid and led late but was caught. BISTRO WEST set a pressured pace and battled between horses then ran on late. SIG AND ZAG showed no speed had a rail trip and was in tight in the turn then altered course and made a late rally. FAST PROMISES rated in the second flight and saved ground, was asked between horses and made a mild rally. N. Y. WISE GUY was rushed up and pressed the pace, contended to the stretch then gave way. SON OF TIGER stumbled at the start, rated in the middle of the pack, was boxed in but made no rally. BIGTIME MAC was void of speed then drifted out and was asked but made no rally. OODLES OF FUN pressed the pace between horses, flashed speed for a half then stopped.
