BELIEVE IN KITTEN sped clear of the field while shifting to the inside in the opening quarter, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin racing into the bend, turned back a challenge from RICO SUAVE racing into upper stretch to regain a clear advantage and held sway to the end under firm handling. The latter gained a contending position between foes in the second flight early, was urged to terms with the pacesetter entering the bend to briefly press the issue nearing upper stretch but proved no match in the last quarter while clearly best of the others. KITCHI WARRIOR tracked off the second flight outside rivals in the opening stages, moved to split foes three deep racing into upper stretch and gained some position while proving no menace to the top pair. TRY A LEMON DROP tracked off the second flight a bit off the inside in the opening half, swung out four wide on the turn while being roused to advance nearing upper stretch but offered no closing response. FALSELY ALARMED tracked the leader three deep as part of the second flight racing into the turn and steadily faded nearing midstretch. BROTHER DR. BOB, forwardly placed along the inside tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight, steadily faded racing into upper stretch. COWBOY LEGACY was pulled up after the opening quarter and was vanned off the course.
