SUGAR KATE was settled out of striking distance outside a rival tracking well off the second flight in the opening half, made steady progress outside foes racing into the far turn gaining position, swung four wide racing into upper stretch and produced a solid late response to just edge SIMPLY GOOD in time under strong handling. The latter tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight while dropping out of striking distance racing into the backstretch, was urged to make a steady advance on the leader racing into upper stretch, moved to gain the advantage between calls in late stages but was just collared on the wire. I O CASHEL, urged to contend with the first flight while caught four wide racing into the first turn, pulled her way clear after a half to set the pace on a commanding margin into the second bend, held sway past midstretch but faltered nearing the sixteenth marker. N'EST CE PAS tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted out to split foes racing into upper stretch gaining some position and continued with a mild bid to late stages. WHO'S CHEATING WHO, reserved along the inside racing to the backstretch, split foes racing through the far turn and continued with interest to gain some position between rivals through the stretch in a belated effort. VERY LUCKY STAR tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening half but lacked the needed closing response. WILDWOOD MIZZ bobbled at the start while breaking slowly and never gained contention. BLUE DOOR tracked off the second flight three deep racing into the backstretch and steadily faded after a half. DEEVEEARE sprinted to the lead from between foes into the first turn and emptied out once headed after a half. PERFECT AMY was a brief factor three wide between foes while being prompted to contend racing into the first turn but retreated early. RUNAWAY ABACO was outpaced early.
