VPERYOD SERYOGA, off a step slowly, was reserved along the rail racing well off the second flight to the far turn, shifted out on the second bend splitting rivals commencing his advance, angled out five wide in upper stretch and found his best stride late to wrest command in time under firm handling. REACH FOR THE SKY was reserved outside foes tracking off the second flight in the opening stages, steadily moved to contention racing four deep through the far turn, shifted nearer to the inside while being roused to challenge nearing midstretch but couldn't match terms with the winner late while appearing to jump some tire tracks nearing the wire. AL'S UNCLE broke slowly, settled outside foes racing to the backstretch, split rivals racing into upper stretch gradually gaining momentum, then angled six wide in the closing stages while finding his best stride late to prevail for a share. MR. PUMPERMICHAEL worked his way to the inside tracking just off the second flight racing into the backstretch, switched out to split foes just off the inside nearing upper stretch, angled back to the inside while racing in some close quarters nearing midstretch but had no final kick. FOREST ELF, forced wide racing through the turn while gaining a forward placing, was firmly rated tracking just off his entrymate racing to the far turn, then steadily faded between foes in late stages. THIRD CRUSADE, bumped at the start, was urged to secure the lead while angling to the rail on the first turn crossing the path of NINE SIXTEEN and impeding that foe, set the pace on a clear margin into upper stretch but gave out in late stages. FOOLHARDY reserved between foes racing to the backstretch, dropped into last after a half and never regained contention. CALEB'S COMET, caught four wide racing to the backstretch while under some prompting to maintain contention tracking just off the second flight, drifted out nearing upper stretch and soon gave way. FANCY HENRY, bumped, then steadied between foes in the second flight racing through the first turn, lodged a brief, three wide bid between foes after a half and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. NINE SIXTEEN broke outwards bumping THIRD CRUSADE at the start, was urged to gain terms with the leaders racing into the first turn, was cut off and forced to check when losing his path to THIRD CRUSADE midway through the first turn while shifting into the path of FANCY HENRY, was righted to track the leaders along the inside to the second bend and steadily retreated racing into upper stretch. VPERYOD SERYOGA WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST TO UNPLACED FOR A MEDICATION VIOLATION.
