REAL DEAL raced close up three wide, rallied to the lead in the stretch and edged clear late. PACIFIC SUNSET was bumped at the start, raced off the rail near the middle of the field and rallied for the place but could not reach the winner. MISS OUTRAGEOUS was squeezed at the start, lacked speed, rallied four wide and loomed a threat in the stretch but lacked a winning bid. I LOVE LISA set the pace from the inside while pressed and weakened a bit. GOLD SPIKE made a bid in the stretch but flattened out. SHE'S WILD raced near the middle of the field, lacked room turning for home and gave way. GALATEA CAT broke inward, pressed the pace from off the rail and gave way.
