LAST GRAN STANDING circled the field six wide and got up in the final strides. DEEP CANYON was off slowly, angled in, split horses, had a brief lead and lugged out in the late going . FOXIE'S BOY set a pressured pace then tired inside. DIAMOND ACCOUNT raced in the second flight inside, split horses, made a bid in the stretch and hung. CARUSO stalked the pace but failed to sustain the bid. DISTORTED GROOM had good early speed off the rail and flattened out.
