Footnotes

BIG BAD MIKE tracked the pace between foes near the inside just off the second flight in the opening half, was steadied momentarily midway through the backstretch when losing his path, continued between foes just off the inside to upper stretch, then came through close quarters racing through the lane to wrest command in time under firm left handed prompting. HENDERSON settled near the inside in the opening half, altered his way out of close quarters midway through the far turn, swung out five wide entering upper stretch and was going well late to close the gap. EXCHANGE IN MOTION sprinted to the lead along the inside, set the pace on a clear margin to the second bend, turned back a challenge nearing upper stretch but couldn't fend off the top pair

late. IMAGE OF GRANDEUR, held up off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, was shuffled back leaving the far turn, then made an effort to regain some position inside foes in the closing stages. IKAROS settled along the inside racing to the far turn, switched out nearing upper stretch and made some mild progress five deep between foes. MALIBU VICE settled off the inside in the opening stages, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and passed some tiring rivals. DOUG JUNIOR tracked just off the pacesetter for a half, lodged a brief bid racing through the far turn but quickly emptied out entering upper stretch. STAR RATING, held up in the opening stages, shifted outside foes nearing the far turn to make brief progress four wide on the second bend but steadily faded in the drive. PROTECTION GAME tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, angled to the inside on the far turn, came under pressure to advance but had no response while shifting out brushing the eventual winner racing through upper stretch. TRILLIONAIRE tracked the pace three deep between foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid in that path midway through the far turn but quickly flattened out. NICKY PART DEUX tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight for a half but steadily faded racing through the far turn. LO ME, caught four wide tracking off the second flight racing to the backstretch, was through early.
