Footnotes

RIVERSHIRE, bumped by UNCLE JEEP at the start, was quickly righted to gain position just off the leaders along the inside in the opening quarter, was held up off those foes losing some position entering the bend, made steady progress along the rail to gain striking distance leaving the turn, shifted off the inside to split foes leaving the furlong marker gaining a narrow advantage and just held the challenge of UNCLE JEEP under firm right handed pressure. The latter broke outwards bumping the eventual winner, was guided off the inside while being reserved just off the second flight, came through close quarters entering the bend while making steady progress, shifted out to split foes three deep entering upper stretch and continued willingly outside the winner to late stages while just being outkicked by that foe. TAPILU, brushed at the start, raced in close attendance to the pace three deep between foes, stalked just off the leaders racing through the bend, was shuffled in traffic near the quarter mile marker but continued willingly a bit off the inside to improve his placing. SHOTGUN LUKE, urged to terms with the first flight along the rail after the opening quarter, took an awkward step midway through the bend while disputing the lead, pressed the issue into upper stretch and weakened in late stages. WAKEUPBRANDON, urged to dispute the pace four deep between foes racing to the bend, angled inwards forcing the issue on the bend and gave way entering upper stretch. DARRELL SAYS bobbed at the start brushing TAPILU, was righted to briefly dispute the pace between foes, eased off the first flight nearing the turn to track outside foes in the second flight and had no rally. GRAZIE, held up out of tight quarters at the start, settled outside a rival racing to the bend and had no rally. A J 'S MOUNTAIN, brushed at the break, was settled along the inside racing to the turn and never gained contention. CAJUN DIABLO was hustled five wide to force the pace in the opening quarter, pressed the issue three deep on the bend and gave way after a half. ROYAL JAKE, caught in tight quarters at the start, was righted to track the pace three wide in second flight, made a brief bid between foes in that path after a half but steadily faded entering upper stretch.
