Footnotes

PROUD NATION secured a position in the second flight tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance under reserve, steadily moved to contention while shifting a bit off the inside on the far turn, briefly awaited an opening after six furlongs, switched out four wide in upper stretch and responded to steadily handling to wrest command and draw clear late. HIS SONG led the second flight a bit off the inside into the backstretch, advanced to challenge three deep midway through the far turn, moved to wrest command between calls entering upper stretch but couldn't contain the winner. STATIC KILL settled off the second flight racing to the backstretch, split foes advancing to striking distance on the far turn, was forced out five wide entering upper stretch and lacked the needed final kick. STREET SWAGGER settled off the inside in the opening half, came around foes on the far turn, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch but continued to improve his position. SLLIM SREVA worked his way to the inside early settling well off the pace, shifted out leaving the far turn to split foes three deep entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve his position. L'AIGLON went up in the opening quarter to force the pace outside a rival, pressed the issue between foes racing through the far turn and gave way entering upper stretch. ARICAT, taken up just after the start, never gained contention. SCORE BABY SCORE sped to the fore along the inside, duelled for command into the far turn and gave way after six furlongs. POWERFUL IMPACT, held up three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out to make a brief, four wide bid on the far turn but quickly emptied out.
