Footnotes

GLOBE TROT tracked the leaders from out of striking distance racing a bit off the inside in the opening stages while under some prompting, continued to make steady progress leaving the bend while shifting out five wide and produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under pressure. KITTEN'S DANCER stalked just off the first flight in the opening stages while shifting to the inside, split foes nearing upper stretch to challenge the pacesetter, gained a narrow advantage leaving the furlong marker but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. MISSED THE POINT tracked off the first flight outside a rival racing to the turn, shifted three deep to bid between foes nearing upper stretch and continued willingly to prevail for a share. TEMPARNILLO, urged to the lead while angling inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to upper stretch, then weakened once headed leaving the furlong marker. ANN OF THE DANCE settled into stride along the inside, continued in last while under some prompting racing through the turn and lacked a closing response. SWEET LEMON CHELLO was urged to prompt the pace outside a rival racing into the turn, drifted out nearing upper stretch and quickly gave way.
