SHANES GOLD sped to the lead while shifting to the rail in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, was roused clear in upper stretch and gamely held the challenge of MAGIC MAN to the end under pressure. The latter secured a forward placing along the inside from the outset, stalked just off the first flight under rating racing into the bend, shifted out in upper stretch while being roused to challenge, closed the gap on the winner to the end but was always only second best. CALL SHOT, held up outside foes in the second flight racing just out of striking distance in the opening stages, advanced on the leaders racing four wide through the turn, couldn't match terms with the top pair in the last furlong but continued with interest to save a share. STORMIN WILDCAT was urged to gain a position just outside his entymate in the opening stages, prompted the pace three deep racing into the turn, continued between foes in that path to upper stretch and weakened in late stages. JIMMY GOT EVEN, reserved off the second flight along the inside racing to the turn, made an effort to improve his placing inside foes racing into the stretch. RICH CITY DUDE tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight while under rating racing into the turn, shifted out in upper stretch and continued evenly between foes. HELLO SAILOR broke slowly, then was held up out of tight quarters at the start, continued under reserve off the second flight racing into the turn and never gained striking position. SPIKEY ITALIANO stalked just off the pacesetter under light rating in the opening quarter, advanced between foes to press the pace racing into the turn, disputed the issue to upper stretch and gave way. RIVRAV was pulled up in the opening quarter and was vanned off the course.
