SAAR stalked just off the first flight along the inside under rating in the opening half, advanced inside foes to press the issue racing into upper stretch, gained a clear advantage and held sway to the end under pressure. YUKAN B CLASSY TOO tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight in the opening half, made steady progress to bid four wide racing into upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but prevailed for place honors. DAKOTA MILKSHAKE joined the pace three wide in the opening stages, pressed the issue in that path racing into the turn and weakened in late stages after failing to match the winner. TWELLO tracked off the first flight between foes in the opening stages, angled to the rail on the turn, came through inside foes to

challenge in upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. SCORE BABY SCORE settled in last off the inside racing to the turn, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. SAILING ALONG tracked the leaders five wide off the second flight racing to the turn and continued evenly outside foes into the stretch. PRIDEINYOUREYES, held up between foes off the second flight racing through the backstretch, never gained contention. CATHYS BREEZE came through tight quarters at the start to gain position in the second flight, shifted in, then out while avoiding some traffic racing into the turn and steadily faded from contention. HIP HOPPER was settled between foes racing into the bend and offered no rally. SIDESPLITTING was urged to contend near the inside in the opening stages, dueled between foes on the turn to upper stretch and gave way. JAUN DE LA PLAYA was a brief factor three wide prompting the pace racing to the turn and emptied out abruptly leaving the three furlong marker.
