Footnotes

BECAUSE I WIN, bumped at the start, was reserved well off the field racing to the bend, swung out seven wide nearing upper stretch steadily gathering momentum and continued widest through the lane while moving to gain the advantage late. COSTLY KING, urged to join the pace along the inside, conceded the lead to track just off the pacesetter while shifting outside that foe, moved to press the issue on the turn, went clear racing into upper stretch but was collared late. SIR KIPLING settled off the second flight early, shifted out six wide nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance and continued to improve position between foes. BLAZING FINISH, reserved along the inside racing to the turn, switched off the inside in upper stretch and continued to improve position. FRIENDIAN tracked off the second flight in the opening stages, was urged to lodge a bid four wide between foes nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the lane. C. C. BANJO settled outside foes in early stages and never seriously menaced. GO POSSE GO was never a factor. PROPER AMERICAN was urged to join the pace outside a rival from the break, shifted to the rail after gaining the advantage racing into the bend, briefly duelled for command on the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. PURPLEGREENANDGOLD tracked just off the first flight between foes racing into the bend and gave way nearing upper stretch. HELLOAGAINMYFRIEND broke inwards bumping the eventual winner at the start, raced four deep tracking just off the leaders for a half and retreated early.
