Footnotes

MEPHISTO ARISTO pulled his way to the lead along the rail, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing to the second bend, drew clear entering upper stretch and held a safe margin to the end under pressure. CASTING tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight, saved ground to upper stretch and shifted out late to prevail between foes for place honors. CONSERVE, off a step slowly, angled to the inside tracking off the second flight, switched out four wide racing into upper stretch and was just outfinished for second. TAP THE DREAM was rated off the second flight outside foes racing to the far turn, angled out five wide entering the stretch and made some belated progress. CLASSIC RECITAL tracked off the second flight early, lodged a brief bid between foes racing through the far turn and flattened out nearing midstretch. LARGE SCALE broke slowly and never gained contention. SIMPLE MAN SKYNYRD, forwardly placed tracking just off the pacesetter racing into the far turn, emptied out in late stages. MR. SWAGGER settled outside foes in early stages and never gained contention. SEVENTYTWO, caught wide racing into the first turn, retreated from contention early.
