Nominations close on Thursday, May 10, 2007 with no fee. \$150 to pass the entry box and an additional \$150 to start, with \$45,000 Added of which 60% of all monies to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHTS: Three-Year-Olds, 119 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Winners of \$50,000 once in 2007, 2 lbs. additional; Non-winners of \$35,000 once or \$28,000 twice in 2007, allowed 2 lbs.; \$30,000 once or \$20,000 twice in 2007, 4 lbs.; (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating allowances.) The field will be limited to twelve (12) starters; Highweights on the scale preferred. Total Earnings in 2007 will be used to determine the order of preference of horses assigned equal weight (on the scale). Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Nominations closed Thursday, May 10, 2007 with 28 nominations.

TEN CARAT RUBY was bothered at the start and was not a factor. CULPEPER MOON was always outrun. POOLETTA raced off the rail near the middle of the field and gave way.
