GRUDGE MATCH shifted to the inside disputing the pace from the break, set the pace along the rail racing through the turn, then edged clear under steady

encouragement through the stretch. CATCH THE TRAIN tracked just off the first flight along the rail racing to the turn, made steady progress inside foes racing into the stretch to prove best of the others. THERE'S NO TELLING broke readily, attended the pace three deep between foes racing into the turn and weakened nearing midstretch. DISTANT BUGLE tracked off the first flight four deep between foes, angled to the rail racing into upper stretch and continued willingly inside foes to the end. ARCTIC POINT, urged to contention between foes in the opening quarter, pressed the pace on the turn to upper stretch and weakened in late stages. SPICY JACK tracked five deep just off the first flight in the opening stages, continued four wide between foes in pursuit of the leaders on the turn and steadily faded. DYNAMIC ROYAL settled between foes off the second flight early and continued evenly into the stretch. TILLO caught six wide racing just off the first flight in the opening stages, continued five deep into the turn and steadily retreated. FEAR NOR FAVOR settled along the inside early and lacked a rally. DEPEND never seriously menaced. IN ALL DIRECTIONS tracked the pace outside foes behind the second flight and never seriously menaced. DONT TOUCH MY GOLD, caught outside foes throughout, steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
