Footnotes

DIXIE CREEK broke outwards brushing ROAR OF THUNDER, was righted to dictate the pace on a narrow margin along the rail, shook clear on the far turn and held safe the challenge of DANCING LEAF under firm encouragement. The latter angled to the rail gaining a position in the second flight, made steady progress to advance on the pacesetter leaving the far turn, closed the gap in late stages but came up second best. COOL STREET settled into stride along the inside in the opening stages, swung outside foes midway through the far turn, raced four wide into upper stretch and made some belated progress. SILVER ROCK STAR settled outside foes racing well off the second flight early but made a steady effort to improve his position racing three deep into the stretch. ROAR OF THUNDER, brushed at the start, was collected to track off the second flight along the inside to the second bend but lacked the needed final kick. ON THE LOOSE AGAIN, reserved along the inside in the opening half, never gained contention. ZEEZEE TAP tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages and steadily faded racing through the far turn. KLIPIT settled near the inside early and never menaced. MY UNCLE CARDIE tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight, lodged a brief, three wide bid on the second bend but emptied out in upper stretch. HONDO WANDO went up to prompt the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch and emptied out abruptly racing through the far turn.
