Footnotes

HAVELOCK gained a position off the first flight racing five deep under rating in the opening half, continued with a steady effort advancing four deep on the leaders racing through the turn, moved to challenge in that path nearing midstretch and prevailed in time under firm handling. LONESOME STREET, forwardly placed along the inside from the outset, moved to press the pace along the rail just before a half, dictated terms on a narrow margin racing into the turn, moved to a clear advantage in upper stretch and just failed to fend off the winner. SCOTUS tracked just off the first flight along the rail racing through the backstretch, saved ground on the bend, came through inside foes to challenge nearing midstretch and continued willingly to close the gap on the top pair to the end. SAN ANTONE, within striking distance four deep between foes in the opening stages, continued with a steady bid three deep between foes racing through the turn but flattened out nearing midstretch. TAPTOWNE, prominent between foes in the opening stages, pressed the pace outside a rival on the turn to upper stretch and gave way. GLEAM OF HOPE was settled outside foes in the opening stages, swung six wide racing into upper stretch and made some mild progress. IOYA BIGTIME was settled between foes off the second flight early, saved ground racing through the turn but lacked the needed closing bid. FAST ALEX was a brief factor three deep between foes attending the pace racing to the turn but dropped out nearing upper stretch. FREE FIGHTER angled nearer to the inside to track between foes in the second flight racing into the turn but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
