MARY ALEX pressed the pace from off the rail, rallied to the lead in the stretch and drew clear late. FOR GILLIAN raced close up off the rail and rallied for the place but could not reach the winner. AROARABLE lacked speed then rallied belatedly up the rail for a share. LUNA SEA set the pace from the inside while pressed and weakened. STAGE GLITTER raced four wide near the middle of the field and lacked a rally. GRAND APPEAL was always outrun. TRY HARDER raced inside near the middle of the field and gave way.
