Footnotes

OCEAN SURGE, in touch with the leaders in the opening sixteenth, was held up off those foes stalking the pace while shifting out three deep, moved readily to challenge entering upper stretch, was carried out a bit by LOSE NONE leaving the furlong marker but found her best stride in the final sixteenth to wrest command and surge clear under firm handling. CANDYONMYMIND broke awkwardly hitting the gate, was settled outside foes, gathered some momentum while shifting out four deep entering upper stretch and continued well enough to secure the place. LOSE NONE, prominent three wide in the opening stages, pressed the pace outside a rival to upper stretch, gained a brief advantage between calls, drifted out leaving the furlong marker while briefly resisting the winner's challenge but gave way once headed by that foe. DAMA DAMA tracked the pace unhurried outside a rival in the early stages, made a brief bid between foes nearing upper stretch but proved empty in the last furlong. REAL AMIGA was hustled to the lead along the inside, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. SPECIAL DIVA, off a step slowly, tracked the leaders along the inside racing to the bend but offered no rally.
