THEATRICAL GIRL was settled in hand outside a rival racing to the backstretch, shifted outside foes after three furlongs, made steady progress racing through the far turn to circle foes four deep and responded to strong handling to wrest command in time. MULATA settled along the inside in the opening half, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch and found her best stride late to edge a rival for place honors. LUCKY GAL secured a tracking position inside foes in the second flight racing unhurried to the backstretch, shifted out to challenge leaving the far turn, gained a brief advantage in upper stretch but failed to sustain her momentum through the final furlong while just lasting for a share. GLADSONG, carried out a bit racing just off the second flight entering

the first turn, continued unhurried while angling nearer the inside entering the far turn, switched out in upper stretch to split foes three deep and continued willingly between foes to late stages. COUNTRY CAUCUS was steadied in traffic while a bit rank in the opening furlong, shifted out making some contact with GLADSONG entering the first turn, continued to track the leaders three deep in the second flight racing into the far turn but had no final response. FLYINGINFORMATION tracked just off the first flight three deep in the opening half, lodged a brief bid in that path entering the far turn but quickly emptied out. LICA'S BLUFF tracked off the second flight along the inside racing into the far turn but never gained contention. LIGHTHOUSE DANCER was urged to secure a forward placing just outside the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, pressed between foes into the far turn and gave way nearing the quarter mile marker. MOGEY angled inwards crossing the path of COUNTRY CAUCUS in the opening stages while being urged to secure the lead, held sway on a narrow margin racing into the far turn, but emptied out quickly once headed in upper stretch. KITTY COVENANT angled inwards in the opening stages to track the pace between foes in the second flight, but came up empty racing through the far turn. DAMA DAMA soon trailed.
