Footnotes

BRIM bobbed at the start, was settled in the last flight racing to the backstretch, made steady progress to gain contention racing three deep on the second bend, moved to challenge for command in that path leaving midstretch and prevailed in time under firm handling. EIGHT GAUGE was settled outside foes in the opening stages, made a steady advance four deep on the backstretch, shifted in on the far turn while moving to challenge for command, gained the lead near midstretch, resisted the winner's challenge but came up second best. ROYAL CANDIDATE broke slowly, settled along the inside for a half, shifted out entering the far turn commencing a steady four wide advance, then continued willingly in that path to late stages to close the gap on the leaders while edging a rival for a share. TENS WILD, held up three deep in the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued in hand drawing into contention entering the far turn, was blocked midway through the far turn, then split foes three deep while racing in close quarters through the stretch and just missing for a share. CHAS THE MAN, caught five wide racing into the first turn while being urged to join the pace, shifted in nearing the backstretch while gaining a narrow advantage, dictated the pace along the inside into the second bend, resisted when challenged racing into upper stretch and gave way late. ACROSS TIME, forwardly placed along the inside racing to the first turn, ceded the lead to a rival entering the backstretch to track that foe, shifted out to make a brief bid racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. VARACRUZ, reserved off the second flight after the opening quarter while guided to the inside, shifted out entering the far turn but lacked a rally. SEASCAPE tracked the leaders along the inside in second flight, then was shuffled back in traffic on the far turn and lacked any further response. SENATOR DAVE, urged to contend four wide between foes racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid three deep between foes entering the second bend but emptied out quickly entering upper stretch.
