EASTERN PRECIPICE, bumped at the start, quickly recovered to gain a position tracking the first flight outside foes from just out of striking distance, steadily moved to terms with the leader while shifting four wide racing into upper stretch and prevailed in time under firm handling. SUSPENDED MOON broke sharply, attended a rival's pace while shifting to the inside racing through the backstretch, pressed the issue nearing upper stretch to gain the advantage approaching the furlong marker but couldn't quite fend off the winner. TRIBUTE TO MOMMA reserved near the inside racing to the turn, swung out six wide in upper stretch and was going well late to close the gap on the top pair while edging a rival for a share. BEYYA broke outwards bumping the eventual winner, was righted to track the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing to the turn, shifted out five wide nearing the furlong marker and continued willingly between foes. SWEETPRINCESSCHARM was urged to the lead, dictated the pace outside a rival on a narrow margin in the opening stages, dueled for command into upper stretch and weakened in late stages. FLEET ENCOUNTER, within striking distance while shifting to the inside early, tracked just off the first flight racing into the turn but had no closing bid. AND HOW tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages and never gained contention. AIN'T NO SAINT tracked off the second flight along the inside early and soon dropped out.
