Footnotes

MONTANA KID secured a forward placing in the opening stages, attended a rival's pace under light rating racing to the second bend, pressed the issue in upper stretch and prevailed in late stages under firm right handed encouragement. PIRATESINPARADISE sped to the fore while angling to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the rail into the second bend, grudgingly resisted the winner's challenge racing through the stretch but couldn't contain that foe. SHOOT THE LOOP tracked just off the first flight outside a rival in the opening stages, continued between foes while angling in racing through the far turn, shifted outside the top pair to challenge in late stages and continued willingly to close the gap. RUNAWAY CAL tracked off the second flight racing to the backstretch, made steady progress four wide on the far turn to gain contention but lacked the needed final kick. IVER WITH AN E settled outside foes in the opening stages, made a steady advance to contention on the backstretch, lodged a brief, three wide bid nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out. CAPTAIN AMERICAN tracked the pace between foes off the second flight early and continued evenly into the stretch. BARANIT settled into stride off the inside early and never gained contention. LEAL RIDGE broke slowly, was switched outside rivals racing to the backstretch and never gained contention while racing four wide through the far turn. SPECIALIST was a brief factor inside foes in the second flight but steadily retreated on the far turn. WILDWOOD PERFECT was steadied while a bit rank racing off the second flight along the rail on the first turn and soon dropped out. DUE TO A TELETIMER MALFUNCTION, RACE WAS HAND TIMED AND PROVIDED BY EQUIBASE.
