**Footnotes**

UNO PECADOR sped clear along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin to the second bend, then was roused to maintain the advantage entering upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. HUNGRY WILDCAT angled inside to track off the second flight racing to the backstretch, advanced to contention along the rail on the far turn, closed the gap on the winner late but was always second best. SWITCHING TO GLIDE tracked the pace along the inside in the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch while moving to challenge the winner but had no final kick. INVISIBLE STAR, bumped just after the start, settled along the inside early, swung six wide racing into upper stretch and made a belated

bid. DENIM settled outside foes racing well out of striking distance in the opening half, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch but continued with interest to improve position. PAISANO CREEK was settled in the last flight racing to the far turn, then split foes near the inside in late stages making an effort to improve position. NIC THE QUICK tracked off the second flight under light rating, advanced to challenge between foes on the far turn but lacked the needed final kick. TURNPIKE TOMMY tracked the pacesetter three deep just off the second flight racing to the far turn but lacked a closing response. HOOCHED EXPRESS tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn, then steadily faded nearing upper stretch. PERFECT CASTING tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening half and came up empty nearing upper stretch. ABACO STORM shifted inwards after the start bumping INVISIBLE STAR, was settled along the inside racing to the backstretch and offered no rally. MILWAUKEE WOLF stumbled at the start losing position to the field and never menaced thereafter.
