Footnotes

DANSEURS NOBLES shifted off the inside while readily moving to the lead in the opening stages, dictated the pace in hand in the opening half, widened his advantage when given some prompting and held sway to the end under steady pressure. MILES AND MILES tracked the pace outside foes while under some reserve early, made a steady advance racing three wide into upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. BEARIFIC tracked just off and outside the pacesetter racing to the bend, couldn't produce a closing bid but continued well enough to earn a share. JUDITH'S LAKE raced unhurried outside foes in the opening, angled out four wide entering upper stretch and made some mild progress late. DANIEL'S MAGIC, off awkwardly, was taken in hand while correcting his course, tracked the leaders between foes but never gained contention. PEDESTAL, reserved just out of striking distance along the inside in the opening half, steadily faded nearing upper stretch.
