Footnotes

STONE FREE broke inwards, was collected to gain position off the second flight while angling inwards a bit, shifted out entering the bend to gain position between foes, bid three deep between foes into upper stretch, was carried out in late stages by TATY'S GOLD but continued with a solid response to wrest command under steady handling. LANTIC, settled off the inside in the opening quarter, swung five wide racing into upper stretch moving into contention, was carried out in late stages but continued with interest to close the gap on the winner. HELLO LOVE was urged to secure a forward placing outside a rival in the second flight, chased the pacesetter between foes into upper stretch and continued willingly to the end while just outfinished by the top pair. TATY'S GOLD was hustled clear of her foes while angling to the inside, set the pace on a clear margin to upper stretch, then lost her advantage while drifting out in the last furlong. A SHOT AWAY tracked the leaders four deep racing just off the second flight early, advanced in that path to make a brief bid racing into upper stretch but flattened out nearing the furlong marker. KEEP ON SINGING, off a step slowly, then pinched back at the break, settled into stride and came around some tiring foes racing into the stretch while making belated progress. ENTY'S GIRL was a brief factor along the inside racing in second flight but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. STORMYS PROCLIVITY broke outwards bumping MY MY MY MARIA, was settled well off the second flight along the inside racing to the turn, shifted out three wide racing into upper stretch but offered no rally. COUNTRY HAM tracked the pace between foes off the second flight racing to the turn and offered no closing bid. MY MY MY MARIA, bumped at the start, angled to the inside chasing the pace, bobbled leaving the seven sixteenths marker and steadily faded.
