Footnotes

IZZY GOLDEN was urged to secure position outside a rival in the second flight in the opening stages, moved to challenge while shifting out three deep nearing upper stretch, wrested command nearing the sixteenth marker to gain a clear advantage and just held the challenge of LIVE FROM APPOLLO under firm encouragement. The latter was guided to the rail in early stages to track just off the second flight, came through close quarters along the rail racing through the stretch and was getting to the winner late. STORMIN WILDCAT, a step slow into stride, raced along the inside to the bend well off the second flight, switched out nearing the quarter mile marker, was fanned six wide racing through the stretch but continued to make steady progress while earning a share. LITTLE BROWN tracked the leaders three deep off the second flight racing to the bend, angled out five wide entering upper stretch and made some mild progress between foes. LOST CAMPER, close up early, tracked the pacesetter as part of the second flight along the inside, shifted out on the bend to bid between foes nearing upper stretch but had no final kick. SPIT SPAT SPEIGHT was hustled clear soon after the break, set the pace along the inside to upper stretch and gave way abruptly leaving the furlong marker. ZAGOR'S WAR settled outside foes in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge. ROCKERFELLER dropped out of contention early.
