### Footnotes

WORKIN FOR HOPS raced unhurried while shifting a bit off the inside as part of the second flight in the opening half, steadily drew on terms with the leaders while shifting out three deep midway through the turn, shook clear when given his cue entering upper stretch and extended his advantage to the end under firm encouragement. PACIFIC OCEAN, reserved off the second flight while working his way nearer the inside in the opening half, angled to the inside entering the turn while moving to terms with the second flight, briefly awaited an opening leaving the quarter mile marker, split foes in upper stretch to challenge inside the winner but couldn't gain terms with that foe. HAVELOCK, held up well off the inside racing as part of the second flight in the opening half, shifted out entering the bend, moved to challenge five deep nearing upper stretch, continued in that path into upper stretch but was outkicked by the top pair. COUNTRY FLAVOR tracked the pace behind the second flight under reserve off the inside in the opening half, angled inwards a bit on the bend while being urged to contention, split foes three deep racing into upper stretch and continued with some interest to improve his position. POINTING NORTH (SAF) joined the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, pressed the issue racing into the turn, briefly resisted the winner's challenge but gave way leaving the furlong marker. COOL BULLET sped to the fore along the inside, dueled for command on the rail into the bend and gave way abruptly entering upper stretch. PULSION tracked the leaders four wide as part of the second flight, made a brief bid in that path between foes racing through the turn but emptied out quickly nearing upper stretch. AKHMATOVA (GB), a bit slow into stride, shifted off the inside racing through the turn but never gained striking distance. QUITE A HANDFUL worked his way to the inside tracking the leaders off the second flight in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch but never mounted a serious challenge.
