WILDWOOD HEIR was urged to dispute the pace along the rail from the outset, moved away to a clear advantage entering the turn, drifted out a bit leaving the midway point of the bend despite his rider maintaining a firm left rein, straightened his course entering upper stretch racing three deep and was roused clear under firm right handed encouragement. FRANKLIN COUNTY angled to the inside tracking the leaders as part of the second flight in the opening stages, advanced along the rail nearing upper stretch to challenge inside the pacesetter but couldn't match terms with that foe in the last furlong. TOP NOTCH BUDDY joined the pace outside a rival soon after the break, relinquished the lead approaching the bend, tracked the pacesetter three deep between foes to upper stretch but couldn't regain terms with the top pair while finishing well enough to earn a share. ON THE RUN tracked the between foes in the second flight while angling inwards racing to the bend, made a brief bid between foes nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed closing response. MILKY MAY tracked the pace three deep in the second flight in the opening stages, was fanned four wide racing into upper stretch and steadily faded from contention.
