Footnotes

VBREEZE, within striking distance from the outset three deep stalking the pacesetter, continued with a steady bid to challenge that foe nearing the quarter mile marker, quickly took over and made the balance of the pace under firm encouragement. CINCO Y CINCO settled into last along the inside racing just out of striking distance to the turn, shifted off the inside in upper stretch advancing in close quarters between foes through the final furlong but continued with interest to prevail for second. KEEP ON SHINING was roused in the opening stages while shifting to the inside pursuing the pacesetter racing into the turn, split rivals nearing upper stretch to lodge a brief bid between foes but lacked the needed final kick. MELO MASON, in touch with the first flight between foes attending the pace racing into the turn, lost some position to the leaders just before a half, then shifted out four wide racing through the stretch while continuing to regain some position in an even effort. BALEGA tracked off the first flight outside foes in the opening stages, advanced to lodge a brief, three wide bid nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out. PHISH FAN stumbled at the start, was hustled to the lead along the rail in the opening stages, dueled for command inside the winner to upper stretch and gave way.
