Footnotes

MISH MOSH broke sharply to gain a narrow advantage while disputing the lead inside foes racing into the turn, shook clear nearing midstretch and extended his advantage late under firm right handed encouragement. JOST VAN DYKE, held up out of striking position near the inside in the opening quarter, shifted outside a rival racing into the bend, angled out six wide entering upper stretch and produced his best stride in the last furlong to edge a rival for place honors on the wire. VILLE, in touch with the pacesetter from the outset racing three deep between foes early, pressed the issue in that path to upper stretch but weakened leaving the furlong marker, then lost second on the wire. PURINCAT tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance while angling to the inside racing into the bend, shifted out four wide in upper stretch while being roused to advance between foes but finished evenly late. UNO PECADOR vied for command between foes just outside the pacesetter racing into the turn and gave way midstretch when failing to match that rival. MR. FLEXIBLE, reserved in last racing off the inside to the turn, was fanned seven wide racing into the stretch and made no real impression. LEVKOS PIRGOS flashed brief pace four wide pursuing the first flight into the turn but emptied out early.
