Footnotes

CITY NUMBER, off last, pulled his way to the lead inside foes in the opening quarter to dictate the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn, held sway a bit off the rail through the bend, then was roused in upper stretch to hold safe the challenge of JUMP 'IEN and maintained a clear margin to the end under firm handling. The latter, reserved outside foes from just out of striking distance in the opening stages, angled inwards a bit on the turn, split foes near the inside approaching upper stretch to challenge just outside the eventual winner, couldn't gain terms with that foe but proved best of the others. OUTLAW ZEN, urged along inside foes in pursuit of the pacesetter, moved to briefly challenge along the rail entering upper stretch but flattened out in the closing stages. DIXIE BANNER, within striking distance three deep in the opening quarter, was fanned four wide while being urged to lodge a brief bid in that path nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. RIVER OF NO RETURN settled into stride near the inside early and never gained contention. BELELIU broke sharply, attended the pace between foes in the opening quarter, was urged along to maintain position nearing upper stretch but quickly came up empty.
