NECHEZ DAWN moved to the fore along the inside disputing the pace from the outset, gained a narrow advantage racing into upper stretch, drifted out despite right handed pressure racing through the stretch and held her foes in a determined effort while shifting out markedly late. SAVANNAH HARBOR bobbled at the start, was collected to track the leaders unhurried near the inside racing to the turn, steadily advanced to striking position along the rail entering upper stretch, couldn't gain even terms with the winner but edged a rival for place honors. FLO'S STRAWBERRY tracked just off the first flight from just out of striking distance near the inside racing to the turn, steadily drew into striking position while shifting out three deep entering upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner and was just outfinished for second. EMONA settled outside a rival racing to the turn racing well off the second flight, angled four wide racing through the stretch and made some mild progress late. LITTLE NIP stumbled at the start, saved ground to upper stretch while gaining some position after a half, then continued evenly in late stages. APPEALING SUSAN was settled into stride off the inside early and never seriously menaced. ZINGWELLA was urged to dispute the pace outside a rival racing to the turn, drifted out nearing the quarter mile marker and quickly gave way.
