PARTY VISION was urged to secure the lead along the inside soon after the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn, shook clear in upper stretch and steadily widened her advantage under pressure. DEHEREWEGO exchanged some contact with SCATTERED EMBERS at the start, was

guided to the rail tracking just off the first flight racing into the turn, then came through inside foes racing into the stretch to prove best of the others. THEPOWER OF BELIEF, within striking distance between foes in the opening stages, eased off the leaders to track those foes outside a rival racing into the turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and continued willingly to the end to gain a share while missing for second. LASTOCHKA, urged to contend while shifting in to the three path in the opening stages, prompted the pace between foes in that path racing into the turn, couldn't match the winner and gave way in upper stretch. ZIPPY TRIP was settled between foes in the opening stages, shifted out of close quarters leaving the gap, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve her position. SO LONG JULIE tracked the pace between foes off the second flight racing outside a rival into the turn and continued evenly to late stages. WAPANUCKA worked her way to the inside gaining a position just off the second flight racing into the turn but lacked the needed closing bid. SONORIS PRIDE, urged to contention four deep racing just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, was urged to briefly force the issue midway through the turn but gave way abruptly entering upper stretch. SCATTERED EMBERS exchanged bumps at the start, was settled near the inside and never gained contention. BARI'S PULPETTE broke awkwardly losing position to the field and never menaced thereafter. PRETTY MARY ELLA hopped at the start, was steadied slightly in close quarters leaving the gap and soon dropped out of contention.
