GENERAL SHERMAN hesitated at the start and was off slowly, lacked speed, angled out for the drive and rallied to be along in time. DAVID K lacked speed, angled out and rallied but could not finish with the winner. LISCARROLL raced close up inside, lacked room when blocked in the stretch then lacked a winning bid. SIR PIKE set the pace from the inside but could not last. STORMING MARINE raced off the rail and made a bid on the final turn but faltered late. THATS OUR LUCK raced close up inside but weakened. THE ALCOVA KID lacked speed four wide and was not a factor. SITEOFWINNER raced close up three wide and gave way. LUCKY MERLOT was always outrun. WARRIOR RIDGE was also outrun. RACE RUN IN LANE 3, RAIL OUT 6 FEET.
