SEVENTEEN ABOVE raced three wide at the middle of the pack and rallied in the stretch but could not finish with the winner. BOOK THE BULLET pressed the pace from off the rail and lacked a winning bid. SUMMER RANGE lacked speed inside and improved her position. PENNY DREAM raced three wide and also lacked a winning bid. THAT'S A STORY set the pace three wide while pressed and gave way. YES SHE'S SMOOTH lacked speed and was not a factor.
