KENNESSEY got squeezed at the start and dropped back, circled the field on the turn and rallied in time. ALBIN was in tight and steadied early then settled, angled out for the stretch drive and led late but was caught. FLYING WARRIOR set the pace and led to the stretch but was caught late. RUM CUSTOMER raced close up early and chased the pace then gave way. RELVADO rated in the middle of the pack then angled out in the stretch and made a late rally. CLASSIC EMPIRE chased the pace, ranged up on the turn and made a mild rally. SARVATHA got squeezed at the start, rated in the second flight, had a rail trip but flattened out. NEAR PERFECT got squeezed at the start and dropped back, had a rail trip but made no rally. FIRST NATIONAL showed no speed early then angled out coming off the turn then ducked in mid-stretch and faded. SOMETHING GAINED was allowed to settle early, contended to the turn then faded.
