Footnotes

WARBIRD gained terms with a rival attending that foe's pace under light rating in the opening half, pressed the issue entering the far turn to gain the advantage midway through the far turn, moved clear racing into upper stretch and extended the advantage to the end under pressure. TRIPLE CHECK tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight under reserve to the second bend, shifted outside rivals racing into upper stretch and prevailed for place honors while failing to menace the winner. MYSTIC settled along the inside behind the second flight in the opening half, saved ground throughout and made some late progress to gain a share inside foes. MEC DANCER angled inwards early to track between foes just off the second flight, shifted out four deep racing into the stretch and continued evenly. FIRE CLOUD settled between foes out of striking distance to the second bend, then split rivals three deep in late stages to gain some position while making no real impression. BLUEGRASS JET was settled last to the backstretch, saved ground throughout and passed inside some tiring rivals late. PRAIRIE BREEZE tracked off the second flight three deep in the opening half and steadily faded racing into the far turn. CANDY TRAIN was urged to gain a forward placing tracking the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, was urged to challenge between foes gaining second racing into the lane but emptied out midstretch. SNAPPED hopped at the start, was righted to track outside foes off the second flight to the far turn but never produced a serious challenge. BLUEGRASS JAM was urged to the lead along the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin to the second bend and emptied out once headed racing through the far turn. LEMONADE KID was steadied a bit along the rail in the opening stages, switched outside foes racing to the backstretch and lacked a rally.
