Footnotes

VICARY ROSE, pulling a bit while racing in close quarters near the lead racing into the first turn, stalked just off the pacesetter under light rating to the far turn, moved to challenge that foe midway through the second bend, lost some position to the leader entering upper stretch but produced a solid closing response to narrowly prevail in time under brisk right handed encouragement. TRISHAS EVEN sped to the fore outside foes in the opening sixteenth, angled inwards nearing the first turn crossing the path of the eventual winner, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin to the second bend, resisted when challenged leaving the far turn and just failed to contain the winner. ADITSAN settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the far turn, angled out four wide entering upper stretch and made some progress to edge a rival for a share. ZIPPING AWAY tracked the pace three deep in the second flight in the opening half, made a brief bid in that path on the far turn but lacked the needed final kick. SICILIAN tracked the pacesetter from within striking distance along the rail in second flight racing into the far turn but came up empty entering upper stretch. TAIBAN MESA settled along the inside racing off the second flight racing to the backstretch but lacked the needed response when called upon racing through the far turn.
