INDIAN CHARLIZE was urged to secure the lead in the opening quarter racing three deep, shook clear nearing the bend while angling inwards, held sway on a narrow margin into upper stretch and just contained the challenge of MYSTERY RIDGE in the final strides under firm encouragement while drifting out and bumping that rival on the wire. The latter, in close attendance to the pace between foes in the opening stages, tracked the leader outside a rival racing into the turn, was urged to challenge nearing upper stretch, drifted out leaving the furlong marker brushing KNOTTS, but responded to firm handling in the final stages to challenge the winner with a solid second effort while being bumped on the wire. KNOTTS tracked the leaders unhurried outside a rival as part of the second flight in the opening quarter, made steady progress to gain striking distance while shifting out four wide leaving the turn, drew on terms with the top pair leaving the furlong marker but lost some momentum when carried out a bit in late stages. GRAND SYMPHONY settled in hand near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out to split foes racing into upper stretch, angled inside foes nearing the furlong marker and continued willingly to close the gap. DANCING IN RAIN worked her way to the inside tracking the leaders off the second flight racing into the turn, gained some position racing into the stretch but made no impression on the leaders. WHISPERING MISSILE broke inwards, chased the pacesetter along the inside into the turn and emptied out entering upper stretch. CHELLY GRAEME tracked the pace inside a rival in the second flight in the opening quarter, shifted off the inside racing through the turn but emptied out early. A TOAST TO BRANDY, caught in tight quarters at the start, soon dropped out of contention.
