### Footnotes

KING DAVID secured a stalking position just off the leaders along the inside, shifted out on the turn splitting foes while readily moving to terms with the pacesetter, pressed the issue outside that foe racing into upper stretch and prevailed in the closing stages following a prolonged drive under energetic handling. TRICKEROY was urged to the fore along the inside soon after the break, set the pace on a narrow margin along the rail racing into the turn, then grudgingly resisted the winner's challenge to the end while just failing to contain that foe. PALADIN'S FURY tracked just off the pacesetter outside a rival in the opening stages, continued in that position while being fanned four wide leaving the midway point of the bend and lacked the needed final response while edging a rival for a share. NAFIR'S BEST, within striking distance between foes in the opening stages, made a brief bid three deep between foes racing into the turn and steadily faded entering upper stretch. EL PRADO'S LUCK bobbled a bit at the start, settled into stride off the inside and never gained contention.
