**Footnotes**

LA TIA pulled her way to the lead along the inside in the opening quarter, dictated terms to her foes on her own courage racing into the turn, steadily increased her margin racing into upper stretch and was kept to pressure. DIVA'S DIAMOND was rated just off the leaders along the inside in the opening stages, made steady progress to gain a position in second flight stalking the leader racing into the turn, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. SMILING MIS, a bit slow into stride, angled to the rail while gaining terms with the last flight in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch and continued with interest to improve her position while prevailing for a share. LIMEHOUSE DANCER stalked just off the pacesetter under light rating in the opening stages, continued to track the leader outside a rival in second flight racing into the bend but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. PLEASANTLYBDANCING, caught outside foes tracking off the second flight early, never gained contention. KAREN'S CUISINE tracked off the second flight between foes racing into the turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. SPIRIT OF A NATION was settled between foes in the last flight but dropped out of contention early.
